

SENIOR NIGHT 2019 GUIDELINES

IMPORTANT- PLEASE REVIEW WITH YOUR SENIOR

1. All members of the senior class are invited to this all-night senior celebration on graduation night. It will run from Saturday, June 1 from 11:00pm until Sunday, June 2 at 5:00am at Hingham High School. There will be music, entertainment, food, and beverages throughout the night.
2. No students other than Hingham High School seniors will be admitted to the party. Check-in at Union Street entrance of school (near auditorium) only.
3. Registration payment, the signed Guidelines, and a completed Medical Consent & Release Form need to be received by Stacy Havens prior to June 2. Students will not be admitted to the party without all these items completed.
4. The deadline for admittance is 11:30pm. Parents of students who have not checked in by 11:30pm will receive a phone call from the Senior Night 2019 Committee informing them that their student has not arrived. If your plans change after registering to attend and you know that your student will not be attending Senior Night, please contact Stacy Havens prior to the event. *(see below for contact info)*
5. The only authorized entrance and exit to Hingham High School will be the Union Street entrance by the auditorium. It is strongly recommended that students be dropped off and picked up for this event. All seniors who do drive to the party should park their cars in the Union Street parking lots.
6. There will be no smoking, vaping, or juuling allowed at the party or on Hingham High School property.
7. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not allowed anywhere on school property. Any Hingham High School senior suspected of alcohol and/or drug abuse at the time of their arrival at the event will not be admitted into the event, and their parent/guardian will immediately be notified. At that point the parent/guardian will be responsible for their student. Hingham Police will be present at check-in and will administer a breathalyzer test.
8. Any prescribed medications will need to be presented at the time of arrival in the original bottle issued by the pharmacy and with the student's name on it.
9. Any student may leave the party at any time during the evening provided that one of the Senior Night 2019 Committee members contacts the student's parent/guardian to come in person to sign them out. **NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO DRIVE THEMSELVES HOME BEFORE THE END OF THE PARTY AT 5:00am.** If a student chooses to leave early, their parent/guardian must pick up the student at the Union Street entrance. No students will be readmitted to the event once they leave. If necessary, student cars may be left in the parking lot until the next day.
10. The Senior Night 2019 Committee members reserve the right to check all handbags, etc. before admittance. All items will be stowed in a secure room for safekeeping until the end of the party. **DO NOT BRING BACKPACKS, LARGE BAGS, PILLOWS, BLANKETS, FOOD, ETC.** Snacks and drinks will be provided.
